

Tips to Keeping Your Dog Safe

You never think something bad will happen to your dog... until it does.

Most of us would never think our dogs would run out into the street and get hit by a car, yet Animal People Newspaper reports that more than a million dogs were struck by cars last year in the U.S. alone.

One of the main reasons these tragic accidents happen is poor visibility – drivers simply couldn't see the dog... until it was too late. These types of accidents happen all too often, whether your dog is on-leash or off.

As pet parents, keeping our dogs safe is our number one priority.

At home, make sure doors and gates are securely closed to keep your dog from wandering into the street

When you and your dog are traveling in a car and your dog is unrestrained:

Don't lower the car window all the way – make sure your dog can't jump out

Make sure to close the car door behind you when you stop for gas

Use a dog safety light to make sure your dog is seen at night, whether he is on leash or off
