

LOCAL LAW #2 OF THE YEAR 2012
PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF
MEMBERS OF THE TOWN OF FAYETTE PLANNING BOARD

Be it enacted by the TOWN OF FAYETTE of Seneca County in the State of New York,
the following Local Law:

Section 1. Authority for this Local Law

This Local Law is enacted pursuant to the authority of Section 271 of the Town Law of the General Law of the State of New York, which authorizes a planning board of a town that has five (5) members on its planning board to increase, by local law or ordinance, the membership of said board to seven (7) members.

Section 2. Increase in Membership

The membership of the Town of Fayette Planning Board be and hereby is increased from five (5) members to seven (7) members with two (2) alternates to serve at such times when a member is otherwise unavailable and its members shall be first appointed for single terms as provided by legislation in order that the terms of its members shall expire in each of seven (7) consecutive years and their successors shall thereafter be appointed for full terms of seven (7) years.

Section 3. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.

Moved by Councilman Nelson and seconded by Supervisor Lorenzetti to approve Local Law #2 - 2012 "Providing for an Increase in the Number of Members of the Town of Fayette Planning Board" commencing immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State. Carried 5 to 0.
