Water Procedures and Penalties

Penalties

If water rents or charges remain unpaid for thirty (30) days or more from the issuance of the billing statement, thereafter a penalty of ten percent (10%) shall be added to the bill.

Procedures for Shut Off

Notwithstanding the provisions of any general, special or Local Law or charter to the contrary, in the event that a water bill remains unpaid for more than sixty (60) days, a shut off notice will be forwarded by regular mail to the owner and occupant of the subject premises. If the unpaid water bill is not paid within ten (10) days of such notice, commencing with the day of mailing such notice, the water supply of the premises will be shut off by the Town. The Town of Fayette will impose shut off of said service only between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Thursday.

Whenever a water supply is shut off for non-payment of a water bill, an additional charge for services in the amount of \$75.00 will be imposed before water is restored.

Procedure for Water Services

That in no event shall a resident turn water services on nor off without the written permission of the Town of Fayette. A violation of said rule shall subject the resident to a fine which will be taxed and assessed pursuant to a procedure duly adopted by the Fayette Town Board.

Re-levy

In all cases where water rents remain due and unpaid at the time the annual tax roll of the Town is made out, the same shall be included therein and levied against the real property on which the water shall have been used and shall be collected with and in the same manner as other town taxes with termination of the collection of water service for the particular property. The said property owner will also incur \$75.00 re-levy service fee that will be added to the tax roll.
