

TOWN OF FAYETTE LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF THE YEAR 2010

WHEREAS, the members of the Town Board of the Town of Fayette, New York desire to abolish the office of the Tax Collector and transfer the duties of said office to the Town Clerk; therefore

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Fayette as follows:

Section 1. The elected position of Tax Collector of the Town of Fayette be and the same is hereby abolished, effective December 31, 2009.

Section 2. On and after January 1, 2010 the duties of collecting and receiving all State of New York, County of Seneca and Town of Fayette taxes and assessments that may be levied in the Town of Fayette, and the duties of transmitting such taxes and assessments to the State of New York, County of Seneca and Town of Fayette, as the case may be, shall be transferred and assigned to the Fayette Town Clerk.

Section 3. This Local Law shall be subject to a mandatory referendum as provided by section 23 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York; shall be submitted for the approval of the electors in the Town of Fayette at the General Election of State and Local Government Offices in the Town of Fayette to be held on November __, 2009; shall become operative only if approved at such election by the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of the Town of Fayette voting upon the proposition; and shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State of New York in accordance with the requirements of Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
