06/13/2019**

Supervisor Lorenzetti called the meeting to order at 7pm with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**PRILEEDGE OF THE FLOOR:** Almost all present spoke at this point, about the elected vs appointed positions. At times it became a heated discussion/debate. Each person spoke between 1 to 11 minutes.

**CODE ENFORCMENT REPORT:** Bob Steele, 5 building permit were approved in the town.

**TOWN HISTORIAN REPORT: ABSENT,** Coreen Lowry reported, Thom has been receiving and answering inquiries about Town. Thom is working on Town History programs for the Stone Church. Also the West Fayette Presbyterian Church Cemetery will be turned over to the Town on 12/31/2019.

**TOWN ENGINEER REPORT: ABSENT,** Cindy Lorenzetti reported that the Conley water project has been given a go. Met on 5/29/2019 with Town of Geneva about sewer.

**TOWN ASSESSOR REPORT: ABSENT,** Coreen Lowry reported that 2 people came to grievance night, it has been a quiet month. The final roll is due to the state July1, 2019.

**HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT REPORT:** Andy Brown, Shannon Drive has been paved. Crystler, Post, Knauss, Yost, Knight, Allen Roads have been stoned. Trucks are up and running. The whole Town has been mowed once. The water van is on its last legs. Andy attended a 3 day highway school in Ithaca. There are 100 loads of millings at the dump for the Town to use on projects. Board directed Andy to speak with the workers about uniforms.

**TOWN CLERK REPORT:** Nancy Murray, The Town took in \$5955.00 for the month of May.
