

LOCAL LAW No. 1 of 2003:

A LOCAL LAW:

PROVIDING A FOUR YEAR TERM FOR THE ELECTIVE OFFICE OF TOWN SUPERVISOR OF THE TOWN OF FAYETTE

Be it enacted by the Town Board for the Town of Fayette as follows:

Section 1. The term of office of elective Town Supervisor of the Town of Fayette, County of Seneca, State of New York shall be four years.

Section 2. At the biennial town election next following the effective date of this local law, and every four years thereafter, the Town Supervisor shall be elected for a term of four years.

Or Alternate

Section 2. Said term of the Town Supervisor of four (4) years shall commence with the election of November 2003, and every four (4) years thereafter.

Section 3. This local law shall supersede in its application to the Town of Fayette section 24 of the Town Law with respect to the term of office of the elective Town Supervisor.

Section 4. This local law shall be submitted for approval to the electors of the Town of Fayette at the next general town election to be held on November 4, 2003 in the Town of Fayette.

Section 5. Any other local law, ordinance or resolution inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed.

Section 6. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State after approval by a majority of the electors voting thereon in accordance with the requirements of Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

LOCAL LAW ADOPTION PROCESS: Resolution Authorizing Adoption of Local Law

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ADOPTION BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF FAYETTE OF:

LOCAL LAW NO. 1-2003: "A FOUR YEAR TERM FOR THE ELECTIVE OFFICE OF TOWN SUPERVISOR OF THE TOWN OF FAYETTE"

WHEREAS, a resolution was duly adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Fayette for a public hearing to be held by said Town Board on April 10, 2003 at 7:00 p.m. at the Office of the Town to hear all interested parties on a proposed Local Law entitled, "A Four Year Term for the Elective Office of Town Supervisor of the Town of Fayette," and

WHEREAS, notice of said public hearing was duly advertised in the Finger Lakes Times as the official newspaper of the Town; and

WHEREAS, said public hearing was duly held on April 10, 2003 at 7:00 p.m. at the Town Office and all parties in attendance were permitted an opportunity to speak on behalf of or in opposition to said Proposed Local Law, or any part thereof, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Fayette, after due deliberation, finds it in the best interest of the Town of Fayette to adopt said Local Law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Fayette hereby adopts said Local Law No. 1 of 2003 entitled "A FOUR YEAR TERM FOR THE ELECTIVE OFFICE OF TOWN SUPERVISOR OF THE TOWN OF FAYETTE," a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part of this resolution, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is directed to coordinate with the Election Commissioners of the County of Seneca to place the aforesaid local law upon the ballot at the next general election as a mandatory referendum for the voters of the Town of Fayette, said general election to be held November 3, 2003; and it is further

RESOLVED, that should such resolution be approved by the majority of voters of the Town of Fayette, the Town Clerk and Attorney for the Town are directed to enter said Local Law in the minutes of this meeting and in the Local Law Book of the Town of Fayette and to give due notice of the adoption of said local law to the Secretary of State of New York and Election Commissioners of the County of Seneca.

Pursuant to a resolution adopted April 10, 2003 under Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, the Town of Fayette hereby adopts a four (4) year term of office for the Town Supervisor of the Town of Fayette. Such term of office will be applied to the term to be filled at the biennial Town election of the year 2005.
