PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR\***Town Justice Riegel-** would like the Board to approve of the position that has been created to replace the Court Clerk. **\*F. Conley-** very upset with the paving job, that was completed on Disinger road. Request that the bill for the job does not get paid until it is redone. **A. Brown,** Sukoat is aware of the way the job was left and will be back to make it right. Has had a hard time getting local contractors, as they don't want small jobs. **\*Trevor Prisem-** recently purchased a home on Watts road and would like a timeline for public water.\* **Dan Compellito & Dan Green-** presented for Community Choice Aggregation, would like Board to pass a local law that would allow them to promote renewable energy to our residents. Attorney Ricci will look into the proposal and report back to the board.

**DOG CONTROL REPORT-** Dallyn Jenkins- quiet month only picked up 5 dogs. It is time for a enumeration in the Town.

**CODE ENFORCEMENT REPORT-**Bob Steele-7 approved permits, 4 complaints are still being monitored.

**TOWN ENGINEER REPORT-** Jason McCormick-working with MRB on sewer proposal. Village of Waterloo moving ahead. Waiting on comptroller report for water district \*, possible approval by next meeting.

**TOWN ASSESSOR REPORT-**James Cleere-Busy with Fire District and sewer. Tax roll was merged for school taxes

**HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT REPORT-**Andy Brown- on top of normal work, the fire hydrant was moved at the water fill station. Still need more information on whether or not we can use CHIPS money to purchase a loader. The several water main breaks on county house road have been due to corrosive soil and the pipe breaking.
