

**TOWN OF FAYETTE
BOARD MEETING
08/11/2022**

Supervisor Jeff Trout called the meeting to order at 7:03 pm with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Priviledge of the Floor:

Don Gee and Gordy and Kathy Mills (not present). Don explained how dangerous the Intersection of Canoga Road and NYS Route 414 are, Gordy and Kathy Mills who were not present have witnessed countless accidents and they would all like to see some sort of change so that no deaths occur. Attorney Ricci mentioned that they have the option to create a petition to have someone come and examine the issue, and have the residents of Fayette sign it and hope that the issue can be resolved.

Dog Control Report:

\$30.00 remuneration fee, Dallyn said its best to have your dog licensed because if they're lost, that's the easiest way to get the dog back. Wants to get contract approved for next meeting. If someone is caught with an unlicensed dog they'll be charged the \$30 in addition to the license

Code Enforcement report:

One small addition permit approved. Construction has been started for Keystone Mills rd.

Town Engineer Report:

Recommends authorization for bid on materials by next meeting for Water District #8 Could use the ARPA money to fund the materials.

Sewer District #1: WQIP is in the process of getting a grant- hopes to be rewarded money so that the cost goes down

Water fill station: Signage is going up. Willy's Water wants to make us the North end purchaser of water. Wants to increase water flow to fill faster, which will require a 2 inch meter, they want to reach a goal of 9-10 min. fill up. The county pays \$10 per thousand

Town Assesor Report:

Has been busy Updating all escrow codes merged files with county Tony's so school tax bills can be out by September 1st minor phone calls and foot traffic this past month

Highway Superintendent Report:

Andy said they have swapped out the dumpsters- its been going well so far. The truck that was broken has been repaired. Have been helping the other townships. Scheduled to do the shoulders of Hoster rd and County rd. They should be fine to pave Chrystler rd.

Town Clerk Report:

\$2,883 brought in for July, \$66 to the NYS Animal Control Program, \$2,817 to the town.

-Motion by Lowry and seconded by Tidball for the WIIA Grant Supporting Resolution. 3/0 Carried.

-Motion by Trout and seconded by Lowry for the MRB Comprehensive Plan Update Approval. 3/0 Carried.

-Motion made by Tidball to Appointment of Alternate Planning Board Members (1) Robert Bilia (2) Christian Rasmussen. 3/0 Carried.

-Motion by Tidball and seconded by Lowry to adopt a retail water fill station at \$1.00 per hundred gallons.

Supervisor Report:

There will be a budget meeting at 4:30 pm at the Fayette Town Hall on 09/01/2022, a meeting following at Muranda Cheese at 6:00 pm for an informational meeting and scheduling of the public hearing.

-Need to negotiate ARPA funds, right now the county has over \$6,000 in ARPA funds.

-The county's water district is not in good shape financially to help.

-The CD with LNB has been renewed (\$5,289).

Committee Reports:

Nothing new for Insurance, Assessment and Public Safety.

Water and Sewer:

WQIP is in the process of getting a grant, hoping to get rewarded with money so that the cost goes down. Willy's Water wants us for anything North for water.

Planning and Zoning:

Training camp at Camp Smith- Tidball plans on attending (August 13th-20th).

-Needs to update the comprehensive plan- public engagement and community polling and surveys.

-The Cornell group wants to go over Hamlet Revitalization.

-There will be a separate Hamlet plan

-The timeline for the Hamlet plan- less than a year to 9 months

-Plans to have it moving by September.

Finger Lakes 1 Proposal:

-Looking for alternate programs to upload content to the website
