

TOWN OF FAYETTE
SEWER DISTRICT INFORMATIONAL MEETING MINUTES
09/15/2022

The meeting was started at 6:02p.m. and ended at 7:08p.m.

-Present: Supervisor Trout, Councilwoman Lowry, Councilman Tidball, Attorney Ricci, Clerk Nesbit.

The sewer line will start at the Town of Fayette/ Town of Varick line and will be a little over 8 miles long. Each home and business will have a pump, everything will get pumped to the Village of Waterloo. There are no concerns so far and the sewer line will be at least 10 feet from the water. Businesses will have more EDU'S than residential units, 1 EDU equals 50 thousand gallons, the EDU'S will be reevaluated annually. The Town of Fayette has already been rewarded 1million dollars in grants, more grants could drop the cost but are more likely to receive grants if there is support. All septic tanks need to be inspected by November, 20 septic systems have already failed so far.
