

**MINUTES
TOWN OF FAYETTE
BOARD MEETING
12/14/2023**

Supervisor Trout called the Public Hearing to order at 6:54 pm-6:55pm.

6:50 P.M.- Fire Contracts with the Village of Waterloo & Border City

6:55 P.M.- Renewal & Extension of the Moratorium on commercial construction.- Maureen Nicholson expressed her concerns to the Town Board regarding the building of Dollar General in the Hamlet of Fayette. Supervisor Trout said that the Board would want to make sure that we didn't allow something that didn't fit with the Comprehensive Plan & the only reason we have continued to extend the Moratorium is because we want the Comp. plan completed first, and any Land Use Regulations changes that would comply with the peoples wishes as demonstrated in the comprehensive plan.

SUPERVISOR REPORT:

Town of Fayette phase 2 WD#8 awarded 1 million dollars. Supervisor Trout would like to thank Craig Peterman from Peterman Lumber for getting the machine for WD#8 to get through all of the rock to finish the 8 inch lines.
